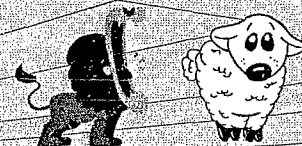
"The Shack" - by William Paul Young


The Shack is taking the country by storm with over three million copies in print and achieving status as a #1 New York Times Best Seller. This fictional book follows the journey of Mackenzie Allen Philips (Mack) as he goes through the "Great Sadness" following the abduction and murder of his youngest child. Mired in the pain of that loss and his own feelings of guilt for it happening, he is confronted with an unbelievable occurrence: an apparent letter from God reaching out to him in his pain and asking to meet with him back at the shack in the woods where his little girl lost her life. What follows is an intense journey into the love that God has for us in and through our pain and the truth of how deep that love is, even when nothing makes sense to us. This is not a book I recommend to all readers; it is best for those who are in two camps - those who have no concept of God and His grace and those whose faith is very secure and able to open their minds to things that will challenge their pre-drawn conclusions with what can end up being a broader and deeper understanding of God's love. It is probably not a great book for those who are so set in their theology and assured that they have God figured all out to the point that anything new that they can learn about Him has to fit what they have already decided. But this is NOT a book about a THEOLOGY OF GOD, it is a book about RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. It is a book that should be finished if it is started so that the tapestry the author is weaving is completely revealed and the picture that is being drawn of God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit is seen in its fullness and not misunderstood by the parts of the picture revealed along the way, because things are not always what they appear at the onset. I found this book to be very impacting on me; I laughed, I cried, and ultimately I have never felt more loved by God. It will challenge the "box" you have God in, but makes a clear statement of Jesus being the only road to God, though He calls people of all backgrounds out of their other beliefs to walk that road. I LOVED this book (even when it was challenging me, or maybe BECAUSE it was challenging me) and will probably read it several times.

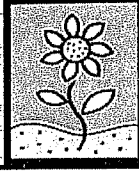

“CORE VALUES”

[12] Those who want to make a good impression outwardly are trying to compel you to be circumcised. The only reason they do this is to avoid being persecuted for the cross of Christ. [13] Not even those who are circumcised obey the law, yet they want you to be circumcised that they may boast about your flesh. [14] May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. [15] Neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything; what counts is a new creation. – Galatians 6:12-15

CHRIST LIVING IN US FROM THE INSIDE OUT

We talk a lot as Christians about transformation—that as the scriptures say in 2 Corinthians 5:17 when we are “in Christ” we are a “new creation,” and that as we see in Romans 12:2 we are “transformed by the renewing” of our minds.” We often judge others transformation by what we see on the outside—we call that the fruit. But is it always? People are fully capable of “going through the motions” doing right things in the eyes of others for that very reason: so others will see it and judge them well. Just as real is the fact that some who seek to do the will of God have moments of weakness and fail to live up to the love they hold for God and the calling He has on their lives. Paul wrote of that when he spoke of the “thorn in his flesh” that God had ALLOWED to remain to keep him humble. Does that mean that Paul wasn’t really a Christian—that he wasn’t really saved—since he did not have victory in all areas of his life? Certainly not if we pay attention to the fact that GOD ALLOWED that thorn to remain, and that it had purpose!

So what are we to do with all of this in light of the fact that we are supposed to be transformed? We often hear the question “If you are saved, what were you saved FROM?” and people will say, “So, if you are saved, WHAT CHANGED?” when we run into a brick wall in our surrender and submission to God’s known will. What they are saying whether realize it or not is, “If you can still do that you must not BE saved!” we can build such a neatly packaged little box for grace to operate in that we can feel very comfortable with how “transformed” we are in comparison to others when they do things we wouldn’t think of. But that box gets bigger and less defined when we fall short ourselves and need a healthy dose of God’s compassion and grace and forgiveness. The bible does say, though that we are to examine ourselves to see that we are in the faith. How does anyone know that if you can’t trust that the good things people do come from a surrendered heart and aren’t just for show, that the bad things people do don’t reveal their heartfelt desire to do better, and if our own hearts are deceitful as the word says in Jeremiah so that we aren’t even sometimes sure

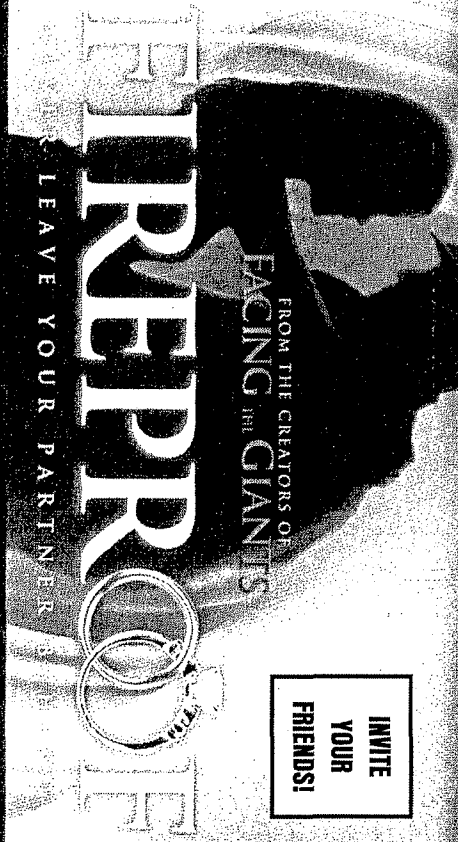
of our own deepest motivations?

Paul wrote to the Galatians (above) and spelled something out for us in the topic of circumcision: What is done on the outside is not what God judges us by but what is on the inside; as it says in 1 Samuel 16:7 “God looks at the heart” - and HE IS THE ONLY ONE WHO CAN DO THAT! So how, then, can we judge others? We CAN’T! But that doesn’t stop us from trying. But with God’s help we CAN examine our own hearts! Do we really WANT to change. Our actions being generated from a genuine desire to obey God is a process, again as Paul says in Romans 12:2 we are “transformed by the renewing of minds.” We become a new CREATION at salvation and that is a and spirit thing which generates a renewing of our minds (God changes our mind about things) which results in our hearts being transformed into surrendered ones. We are all in different phases of this journey and God does not bring us together into a family to judge one another for how far we fall short but to help each other become stronger and experience victories. He brings us together to provide encouragement, compassion sharpening (as iron sharpens iron) and be the hands of feet of Jesus so that all can experience His love, grace, mercy, and forgiveness.

With Christ every day is a new beginning and that is what is represented in the name we have chosen for His church here. Ours is not to reject those who fall short of the glory of God, to judge those who don’t measure up as less than genuine but to help each other to draw closer to Jesus so that He can more and more finish the work He wants to do in all of us which will produce transformed lives and genuine good works from a surrendered heart—Christ loving us from the inside out. In a world that seems upside down may we be a people allow God to help us and helps us to help others let Christ live in us from the inside out!
